Phase #4 - next Little League Baseball Organization/playoff format

Arrange international amateur competition along the lines of Little League Baseball. When this Phase #4 is fully developed: Multiple city teams to compete for City titles. City team winners to compete for state/provincial/prefecture titles. State/provincial/prefecture winners to compete for National titles. National winners to compete for Federation titles. Federation winners to compete for World title. Sanctioned league play must be according to "Official Rules" developed by Taylor Sports, L.L.C., must use the Taylor Sports Boot'r and use Taylor Sports' W.I.S.A. as the sport's governing body.
