ICE SOCCER is an emerging new sport where competing teams try to score by kicking a projectile, the **Boot'r**TM, through the opponent's goal. The Boot'r is not a ball; it is uniquely shaped and play-action weighted to allow sustainable, controlled play. Professional leagues are envisioned by the year 2020.

What

- A team sport played on ice without ice skates
- Designed for competitive league play
- Easily adaptable for casual, family-recreational play

Where

- Indoor ice arenas
- Outdoor ice surfaces comparable in size to indoor ice arenas
- Frozen lakes, ponds, flooded/frozen back yards of any size

Who

- Ages 10 and above
- All male, all female or co-ed teams
- Anyone in reasonably good physical shape
- No advanced physical conditioning or highly developed skill set required to have a good time

When

- Available ice time – varies, depending on targeted clientele
- Summer/winter/shoulder-season leagues – whenever/wherever there is ice

Teams

- Adult on-ice teams at full strength – nine (9) players – with rule provisions for 1-2 players short
- Youth on-ice teams at full strength – ten (10) players – with rule provisions for 2-3 players short
- Casual, family/neighborhood “sand lot” play - numbers will vary with size of ice surface available and number of players present.

Equipment

- The Boot'r, which allows controlled, sustainable play – get ordering information at:

 - adult version
 - youth version (boys 10 – 13/14 and girls 10 – 17/18)
- Footwear
 - regular treaded winter footwear with well-defined and substantial toe box (“dirty” ice)
 - hi-traction-on-ice shoe-boots (“clean” or “dirty” ice) – get ordering information at:
http://www.icesoccer.com/ordering_shoes.html
 - not allowed: “sneakers”, skates, or cleated/spiked footwear
- Protective Gear
 - helmet (mandatory)
 - elbow pads (mandatory) and knee pads
 - hip girdle with “tail bone” protector
 - goalie: above equipment, plus face guard on helmet (mandatory), shin guards, chest protector and heavy gloves

Rules

- Scoring - like regular field soccer
- Game length – 30-60 minutes, depending on ice time available
- “Zoning Off-sides” - very different from other sports
- Penalties for play infractions and unsportmanlike conduct
- Cannot use hands and/or forearms to control or direct the Boot’r
- “Heading”, “slide tackling”, “aerobic kicking”, “boarding” and “body checking” not allowed
